





Credits

The HJIS transcript indicates one's grades on the 7-scale from Grade 9 to 12. A cumulative 7-scale grade is converted into a 4.00 GPA scale. Successful mastery (4 to 7 out of 7) of a subject is awarded 1.00 credit per year. If a grade of 3 is achieved, students receive 0.5 credits. In Theory of Knowledge (TOK), the number of credits are divided by half (0.5 and 0.25 credits).


Upper Secondary School

All HJIS Upper Secondary (Grade 11-12) students are enrolled in DP subjects. Students can take one of two pathways: the IBDP Diploma or DP course candidacy. Students in the IBDP Diploma pathway take three HL subjects and three SL subjects in addition to three core components: Creativity Activity Service (CAS), EE and TOK. Students in the Course Candidate pathway complete six subjects and two core components: CAS and TOK.

Global Citizenship and Service

As stated in our vision, HJIS is a community of global citizens who actively promote more peaceful, tolerant, inclusive, secure and sustainable societies by understanding and taking action on global and local issues. Service Learning is at the heart of our school, as seen in our Core Values of understanding, respect and community. As a result, all students nurture the attributes of Global Citizenship by completing their MYP Service Learning requirements as well as DP CAS requirements in full.
